

Mykhailo Illienko (born June 29, 1947, Moscow) - screenwriter, actor, (2017). Honored Artist of Ukraine (2003). Laureate of the State Prize of Ukraine named after Alexander Dovzhenko (2007).

Mikhailo is the organizer of the Open Night Film Festival since 1997 .

He has been a dean of the Film Faculty of the Kiev National University of Theater, Film and Television named after Ivan Karpenko-Kary since 2000. Member of the Ukrainian National Union of Cinematographers.

From April 2017 to November 2018 he was the Chairman of the Board of the Ukrainian Film Academy.





Sergey Proskurnya (born November 28, 1957, Lviv) is a Ukrainian theater director, producer, laureate of the Experiment National Union of Ukrainian Theater Workers (2001) and Sergey Danchenko (2017) awards.

The author of the concept and the chief director of the non-traditional genres of art festival “Vyvyh” (Lviv).

Sergey was awarded the Order of Merit, II degree in 2017.





Ekaterina Kondratenko better known as **Katya Chilly** (born July 12, 1978, Kiev) is a Ukrainian singer, musician and composer, folklorist by education and vocation.

Released five albums, attracted significant attention from the press and viewers. In 2017, Chilly participated in the seventh season of the vocal talent show "Voice of the Country", reaching the semifinals. The project marked the return of Ekaterina to the Ukrainian stage. This year Katya took part in the Eurovision National Selection.

She is one of the most extraordinary and unique Ukrainian performers. Her songs are exceptional!





Vasily Barkov was born in 1972 in one of the Bessarabiat villages in Ukrainian. In 1998 he graduated from film and television directing at the National Academy of Theater and Cinematography in Sofia, Bulgaria.



Director, screenwriter and producer of documentary and feature films: Bessariabia, My Love (1998) Shakespeare's Balkan Style (2002) Glory to Bulgaria (fiction, 2003); The Last Journey (fic., 2008), One shot (2009); Emergency landing (2009); Monument and his brother (2012), etc. Some of his works have won national and international awards. Therefore, his experienced eye will also select the winners!



Rimma Zyubina (August 23, 1971, Uzhgorod) - Ukrainian actress, TV presenter, social activist. She is recognized as "Best Actress 2016-2019" by the "Filmed in Ukraine" rating.

Rimma is the president of the FilmFestBuk children's film festival at the Bukovel-Artek children's center in 2016-2017. Host and author of the program "The Way Home" about orphans at UA.TV 2018 and several other programs.

Has played over 50 roles in the theater and 100 roles in films and television films.

According to the Focus magazine in 2017, she entered the 100 most influential women in Ukraine. She is also among the 100 women noted by the All-Ukrainian rating magazine "Pride and Beauty of Ukraine" 2019.
